Data Assembly

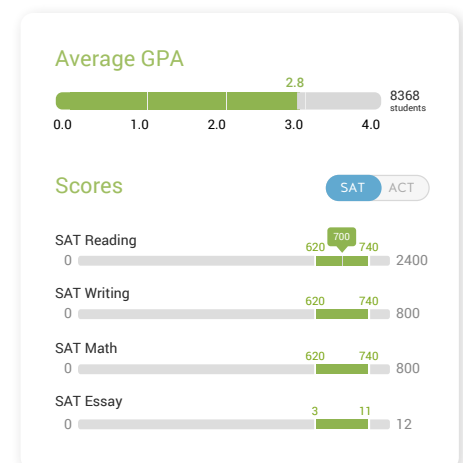
We'll take care of the heavy lifting of combining and cleaning your SIS data, college counseling records, and data from the National College Clearinghouse.

Actionable Insights
